Northern Animal Clinic – Boarding Policy and Admission Form

As a service to our clients, NAC provides boarding for your dog or cat. Please be assured that your pet will receive the following:

- * A safe and clean environment
- * A climate controlled environment
- * Observation for signs of illness
- * Daily individual exercise

All boarders must be current on their vaccinations and proof must be provided. Vaccinations must be administered by a licensed veterinarian. The following are NAC vaccination requirements:

CANINE: Distemper Combination Series – Rabies – Bordetella – Current Intestinal Parasite Screening

FELINE: Distemper/Upper Respiratory Series – Rabies – Current Intestinal Parasite Screening

The following are recommended:

Canine: Heartworm/Tick Borne Disease Screen Feline: FeLV/FIV Testing and Leukemia Vaccination

You will receive an additional charge for the following services:

- Elimination of external (fleas/ticks/ear mites) or internal parasites if present
- Emergency Veterinary Care if your pet becomes ill
- Insulin injections: \$5.00 per day YES NO
- Special Needs Boarding Care: \$5.00 per day YES NO
- Bath and Nail trim (if cooperative): \$17.00 YES NO
